IDEA GARDEN RECEPTION

Beginning at 6:00, the fragrant Idea Garden will set the stage for our guests to savor light appetizers and Chaddsford Winery offerings, accompanied by live music from the Britton Brothers. This hour-long reception will allow time to wander into Longwood's Music Room and enjoy the visual splendor of a special one-day exhibit entitled *The Art of the Asian Pear*, created especially for PASA by Subaruashii Kudamono, an extraordinary orchard in the Lehigh Valley.

DINNER IN THE CONSERVATORY

Beginning at 7:30, guests will take their seat at our Harvest Table in the Conservatory and enjoy a remarkable first course featuring foods grown at Rushton Farm. Aaron DeLong, Farm Manager of the Rushton Farm & CSA (a project of the Willistown Conservation Trust) will present his unique inside view of this nationally-recognized farm project. Our second course will feature beef from Cressbrook Farm, Grand Champion Winner of PASA's 2009 100% Grassfed Beef Cook-Off (*vegetarian option available*). Our extravagant dessert course will feature an Asian pear tart, using fruit from Subaruashii Kudamono orchard. We'll savor fair trade coffees & teas as we appreciate remarks by Paul Redman, Director of Longwood Gardens, and Brian Snyder, PASA's Executive Director. As a fun treat for our guests, we are organizing a *Live Auction of Extraordinary Experiences and Artifacts* to conclude the night.
